- The brass nut and saddle for balanced open string response and increased sustain.
- The elegant mahogany sides and back for strength as well as beauty.
- The rosewood fingerboard and bridge for beauty and durability.

Dreadnought body • Aged solid cedar top with hand-stained mahogany finish • Mahogany sides and two-piece back • Brass nut and saddle • Brass side and main position markers • Rosewood fingerboard and bridge • Maple binding and purfling • Rosewood string pins and end pin • Gold plated, sealed tuning machines.

THE 78/12 DAION HERITAGE CHITAR

The same basic guitar as the model 78 with slotted headstock • Gold plated 6 on plate tuning machines.

THE 79 DAION HERITAGE GUITAR


Dreadnought body • Aged, solid cedar top • Mahogany sides and two-piece back • Durable, high-gloss black finish • Brass nut and saddle • Rosewood fingerboard and bridge • Brass binding • Rosewood string pins and end pin • Gold plated, sealed tuning machines.

Note attractive hand-carved mark on head piece; the gold plated, sealed tuning machines; and, the brass nut.

Hardwood neck with rosewood fingerboard has brass main and side position markers.

The distinctive maple rosette inlay around sound hole and the rosewood bridge & pins with brass saddle combine to create a tone of elegance and professionalism.

The sides and back are beautifully formed from mirror-matched mahogany.








